Requirements

All artists accepted must be living and working in Michigan. Art pieces submitted for consideration should fit the described theme, and be 2 dimensional of any medium, prepared for display and sale, with the ability to be hung on a wall, propped on a picture rail, or displayed on an easel – painting, drawing, photography, collage, digital art, prints, metal, fabric arts, etc. No minimum size. Maximum size is approximately 48 x 60 inches. Artists set the selling price and will receive 60% of said price at the conclusion of the show if the pieces are sold.

If artists' wish for their work to be insured, they must carry that insurance themselves. Pieces submitted for consideration should include a web-ready photo. Stillwater Stables will handle the installation and on-site presentation of all accepted works. Promotion includes a feature on the company's website www.stillwaterstays.com and on social media. Artists with works on display will also be invited to enjoy a complimentary 1-night stay in one of the cabins at Stillwater Stables.

*Art must be ready for collection by the deadline of **April 15, 2023** for display at the property from approximately **May 1 through August 31, 2023**. Artists are encouraged, however not obligated, to leave the works at Stillwater for this length of time. Inquire if you have other timing requests/ needs for your work. Guests and visitors at Stillwater Stables will be invited to purchase the art works and take them home at any time throughout this period. The specific artworks submitted may not be made available for sale at any other location, including online, for a lesser amount. All pieces sold*



while hanging at Stillwater are subject to the commission fee. Arrangements will be made for personally collecting and transporting the works to the property. Artists will also be welcome to deliver their work directly to the property if desired.

About the Stillwater Art Show

Stillwater Stables & Field Club is a 60-acre lakeside equestrian destination that features tiny guest cabins for stays plus a unique event and studio space above the horse stables. The farm is located in Ortonville - about 50 miles north of Detroit.

Rachel Erin is the steward of the property and host along with her partner, Scott Stangeland. When Rachel isn't messing about with horses, she's busy at the helm of Stillwater Collective, a communications arts agency dedicated to creative strategy and design.

In an effort to display and promote our rich pool of talented local artists as well as enliven and enrich the guest experience at Stillwater, Rachel has teamed up with Rebecca Scarcello, a metro Detroit arts advocate and event curator, to offer the first in a series of events and installations dedicated to supporting and sharing the arts at Stillwater.
